



Mass Teacher Resources (MTR) helps teachers in Greater Boston at economically disadvantaged schools access the resources needed to create welcoming, inclusive, and safe learning environments for students. We provide free classroom supplies to teachers at Title 1 elementary and middle schools (K-8) in 70 communities in Greater Boston through the MTR Free Store, located in Woburn, MA.

Teachers in Massachusetts spend an average of \$750 each year of their own money on classroom supplies.



Items purchased most often include basic school supplies as well as bulletin board materials, instructional aides, craft supplies and student incentives. Over the course of a career this spending can add up to tens of thousands of dollars. For many educators, it is a determining factor in their decision to leave the profession.

There is a real crisis in public education. For local districts in Gateway communities, with funding shortfalls or those struggling with low test scores, teacher retention is a constant challenge. Across the state, the average teacher retention rate year to year is 75%; in high needs communities the average is 60%. Each year, these districts lose almost half of their teachers. In this situation new teachers lack mentorship and support, and the cycle of attrition continues. And some of the most atrisk children in the state too often pay the price.

In September 2024, MTR opened the only Teacher Free Store in the state. Our goal is to serve as a source of support for local teachers, to

help alleviate the financial burden they take on to ensure their students have the supplies they need to learn. The MTR Free Store is also a place where teachers can meet and talk and learn from each other. The impact is that teachers feel more supported and can more fully focus on their students' educational needs. Students thrive in classrooms with equitable access to supplies and materials. An added benefit: PTOs can allocate funds to student enrichment, and not classroom supplies. The outcome is higher teacher retention and student achievement – a real win-win for our public schools.

The MTR Free Store

The MTR Free Store at 400 West Cummings Park, Woburn, is a convenient and accessible space for local teachers to shop for free school supplies. Items available include classroom and office supplies, curriculum materials and workbooks, cleaning supplies, arts & crafts materials, instructional aides, and books for students of all ages.

The MTR Free Store serves teachers at Title 1 elementary and middle schools (K-8) in Greater Boston, broadly defined as encompassed by Routes 128 and 495. Teachers book an appointment to shop online, providing basic information about their students and school. A district-issued ID is required at store checkin; teachers then browse the store, selecting the items they need from existing inventory.

This school year 234 teachers from 62 schools shopped the MTR Free Store.

More than 6,400 students across 25 communities will benefit from these supplies.

Store Sponsor - \$10,000

The MTR Free Store Sponsor will be clearly identified through 11" x 14" framed signage placed prominently at the store entrance and in the display window.
